SERIES INFORMATION

- ❖ To qualify for series awards an athlete must participate in at least 5 out of 6 races.
- ❖ Series awards will be awarded to the top 10 males and top 10 females in two concurrently running series: Advocare Champion Series & Spark Challenge Series.
- ❖ The series awards will be awarded at the September 25th event.
 - **Advocare Champion Series**
 - Points are awarded according to overall finishing time of each race.
 - Points are awarded to every finisher in the race based on the number of starters of the entire race.
 - Example: if 189 people start the half marathon race – the winner will receive 189 points. Each 30 K finisher will receive 1 less point until the last finisher receives 1 point.
 - All divisions are eligible.
 - **Spark Challenge Series**
 - Points are awarded in the listed divisions.
 - Points are awarded to every finisher in the division based on the number of starters.
 - Example: if 49 people start the Men's 35-39 division the winner of Men's 35-39 division will receive 49 points. Each finisher will receive 1 less point until the last finisher receives 1 point.
 - All divisions are eligible.

SERIES INFORMATION

- ❖ To qualify for series awards an athlete must participate in at least 2 out of 3 races.
- ❖ All 3 events are Florida Points Series.
- ❖ Series awards will be awarded to the top 10 males and top 10 females in two concurrently running series: Advocare Champion Series & Spark Challenge Series.
- ❖ The series awards will be awarded at the September 25th event.
 - **Advocare Champion Series**
 - Points are awarded according to overall finishing order.
 - Points are awarded to the first 15 finishers in the race.
 - Example: if 64 people start the category 3 race – the winner will receive 15 points. Each finisher will receive 1 less point until the 15th finisher receives 1 point.
 - All divisions are EXCEPT Category 5 masters categories are eligible.
 - **Spark Challenge Series**
 - Points are awarded to every finisher in the division based on the number of starters.
 - Example: if 49 people start the Cat. 5 (35-39) division the winner of Men's 35-39 division will receive 49 points. Each finisher will receive 1 less point until the last finisher receives 1 point.
 - All Category 5 masters racers must race with an AMB transponder.
 - Only Category 5 masters categories are eligible.
